Objectives: During the workshop, participants will

- consider and explore the issues for children and young people in moving on
- discuss difficulties and any barriers in preparing children and young people to move on
- identify strategies to overcome any barriers as well as the type of support needed during the preparation period
- acknowledge the feelings that everyone concerned has when a child or young person moves on from a placement

Method: This workshop will be highly participative, using practical examples and exercises to help everyone relate the learning to their fostering
