Objectives: During the workshop, participants will

- learn who to approach for different issues and situations

- understand the roles, responsibilities and expectations of all involved

with fostered children

- prepare ways of being heard and speaking on behalf of a fostered child

or young person

- gain skills and practical ideas for handling meetings with other

professionals

exercises to help everyone relate the learning to their fostering role

Skills to practise and develop

- * Questions to gain information and change direction
- * Active listening to build rapport and trust
- * Summarise and get commitment to action
